Your organisation should have a planned programme of evidence-based Relationships, Sex Education and Health Education (RSHE) which tackles age-appropriate issues such as:



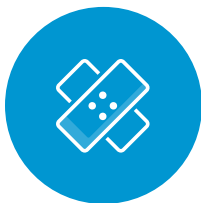
Healthy relationships
